



New Tenant Payment Options

Automatic Bank Draft:

- Automatic Bank Draft is the stress-free way to pay your bill on time every month. Because your payment is automatically withdrawn from your bank account, you don't have to worry about paying it on time. You'll still receive a monthly bill listing the amount and payment due date; however, the funds will be electronically transferred from your bank account on the date you request (Electronic Funds Transfer/EFT).

Benefits of automatic bank draft include:

- Avoid late or missed payments
- Save time, postage and check costs
- It's FREE!

One Time Payment/Website (With Fee)

- Welcome to EZPay, a convenient payment service offered to Lakeland Linder International Airport tenants by our payment processing agent, Kubra Data Transfer LTD. Kubra charges a non-refundable convenience fee of \$2.75 per \$5,000 transaction, which will be charged to your bank account. Payments made before 5:30 p.m. will post to your account on the same business day.
 - Path for one-time payment is located on Lakeland Linder International Airport's website: www.FlyLakeland.com, go to "For Tenants" and then "Continue to EZPAY". You will then be directed to our partner's website, Lakeland Electric.
 - You will need your account number to make a payment. Your account number is located on the top right portion of your invoice.

- Customers may also call Lakeland Linder International Airport at 863-834-3298 to make a payment. A \$2.75 fee per \$5,000 per transaction will apply.
